They are to be read during whole class reading slots and are for enjoyment.

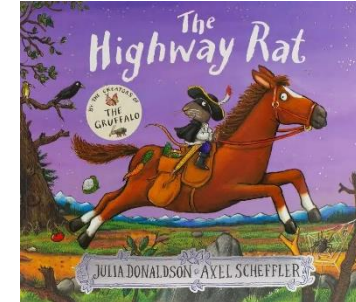
